

## ANNOUNCEMENT - RESTRUCTURING OF SISV

SISV currently comprises the General Council and three (3) divisional councils representing the disciplines of valuation, quantity surveying and land surveying. The constantly changing external environment has morphed the industry to require complex solutions and highly specialised skills to meet the rising needs of clients. To meet the new challenges, SISV is restructuring itself for more effective responses to the evolving needs.

While we have constantly been upgrading ourselves both in knowledge and skills, allowing greater autonomy to each discipline to chart its own growth and responses will facilitate more efficient and focused services. This calls for the establishment of three (3) separate Councils covering the various disciplines.

The new formation will provide each Council with the autonomy to manage its own professional development and divergent roles and yet remain united to develop and project an elevated professional profile based on the many common grounds. To facilitate the change, SISV revised its constitution to institute the constitution of three (3) councils with a president for each council.

I am pleased to announce with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> April 2014, SISV will operate under a new constitution whereby the various disciplines will come under three (3) separate Councils with each Council functioning independently and performing different roles.

The 3 Councils headed by the respective Presidents shall be as follows :-

- 1. Valuation and General Practice Council : Dr Lim Lan Yuan
- Quantity Surveying Council
  Land Surveying Council
- : Mr Silas Loh : Mr Loi Hwee Yong

The position of the Council Chairman is no longer identified in the re-organised structure.
